Thursday, September 17, 6:30 pm Victorian Square Walking Tour and Hosted Dinner

Meet your local guide in the hotel lobby to enjoy a walking tour of the Victorian Square area located right outside the hotel door. Sparks was established in 1904 when the railroad buildings were moved to the eastern border of Reno. The new city was named after Mr. John Sparks, the State Governor at the time. Your professional guide will take you through the Square and tell you all about the Basque Cultural Heritage in the area, the points of interest, history and tell you stories about the many characters who settled here. Your walking tour will end at the Great Basin Brewing Company, a local dining tradition. Here you will enjoy a Mixed Grill Buffet to include tossed salad and dressings, freshly made beer bread, ale marinated steak, barley crusted chicken, broccoli Garlic Fettuccine, sautéed seasonal vegetables, garlic red potatoes, non-alcoholic beverages and dessert (TBA). After dinner it is just a short walk back to your hotel. This is a perfect way to spend a fall evening!

Friday, September 18, 4:45 pm Eldorado Hotel/Casino Showroom, "42nd Street" Broadway Performance, Buffet Dinner, Guided Reno City Tour

Our professional guide will meet you at the Nugget Bus Loading Entrance on 11th Street for a 4:45pm departure to the Eldorado Hotel/Casino. En route, enjoy a driving tour of Reno to include Millionaires Row, the River Walk and Arts District, the University of Reno Campus, a drive under both the old and new Reno Arches, and more. Upon arrival at the Eldorado enjoy one of the best dinner buffets in town. This buffet offers many different cuisines and wonderful desserts. Next, be escorted to the Showroom for a performance of "42nd Street". This show is based on the novel by Bradford Ropes and the subsequent 1933 film adaptation, and focuses on the efforts of famed dictatorial Great White Way director Julian Marsh to mount a successful stage production of a musical extravaganza at the height of the Great Depression. The music, dancing and costumes are incredible. Afterwards, board your coach and return to the Nugget with arrival scheduled for 9:45pm.

Saturday, September 19, 12:45 pm Historic Virginia City & Carson City Tour Combo

Your group will be conveniently picked up at the 11th Street bus loading entrance and travel via chartered motorcoach to historic Virginia City. Your journey takes you up Geiger Grade giving you spectacular views of Reno, the Washoe Valley and the Sierra Nevada Mountains. Sit back and relax as your guide gives narration on the history of the area as you ride along. Upon arrival, enjoy a brief driving tour followed by 2 hours in this former gold and silver rush town to explore and sightsee. Walk along the wooden sidewalks of yesteryear as you browse through the saloons, museums, casinos and gift shops. This is a great place to pick up that unique souvenir of your trip. Virginia City has so much history and you will have plenty of time to explore and experience the town. Have lunch on your own before departure to Nevada's Capitol City, Carson City. Here you will take a guided driving tour of the historic district to include the Krebs-Peterson House (site of John Wayne's last film "The Shootist"), the Ferris Mansion, the Governor's Mansion, the Legislative Buildings and Capitol Mall and more. Your Carson City tour will end at the Nevada State Museum, formerly the US Mint. Here you will enjoy the exhibits, the western town and mine re-creation, and displays giving you an overview of Nevada's history. Return to Reno via the scenic Washoe Valley with arrival back at the Nugget scheduled for 5:45pm.
